




Organization of NEP 2020 Webinar


Knowledge dissemination by resource person


Knowledge gained by you about "The Overview of curriculum and pedagogy, regulations and accreditation"


Understanding of Optimal Learning Environment for Innovation and Research Opportunities


Exposure gained regarding Professional Education and Leadership for Higher Education


Overall awareness gained regarding Reforms and Transformation in NEP 2020


