

Points Discussed:

The meeting began with welcome address and the introductory remarks by the Principal.


1. Dr. Jayanth J has briefed the IQAC activities and the initiatives by the IQAC about the last meeting agenda and discussion.

2. GSSSIETW is actively working towards establishing an incubation center on campus to promote innovation and support startups in the Mysuru region. The Principal provided an update on the initiatives, including the submission of a proposal to the Department of Science and Technology (DST), Government of India, for the establishment of the incubation center.
3. The Principal emphasized the importance of establishing department-wise technical domain clubs to enhance students' skills through various departmental activities. He highlighted the benefits of these technical clubs and their significance in fostering student development.
4. Dr. Jayanth J, IQAC Director, provided an update on the progress of the 2nd Cycle of the NAAC accreditation process. The Principal emphasized the importance of setting deadlines for regular reviews to ensure the smooth and timely completion of the Self-Study Report (SSR).
5. The committee members stressed the need to strengthen alumnae engagement and build a robust network. They also recommended the development of an online portal to facilitate seamless interaction and streamline database updates.
6. The Principal urged all departments to develop strategies, in collaboration with the placement cell, to enhance on-the-job training and internship opportunities for students.
7. It was suggested to organize a Faculty Development Program (FDP) focused on research methodology to elevate the quality of faculty publications in journals, patents, and other scholarly outlets. The FDP should aim to enhance faculty members' research skills, promote rigorous methodologies, and improve the overall impact of their work.
8. Encourage the Students to engage in real-time projects that contribute directly to institutional applications. This approach will not only enhance their practical experience but also provide valuable solutions for the institution. By working on these projects, students can apply their skills in meaningful ways and contribute to the institution's growth and innovation.
9. The Principal emphasized the need to establish MoUs with multinational companies to enhance the skills of students and faculty. These partnerships are intended to offer valuable training and development opportunities, bridging the gap between academic knowledge and industry practices.

Collaborating with global firms will help elevate the institution's educational standards and support professional growth.

10. Dr.Jayanth J Director-IQAC proposed the vote of thanks along with the immediate action plan.
