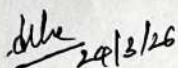

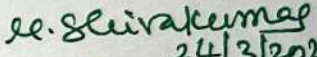

Dr.Kumar R N emphasized on the SDG. The Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) are a set of global goals established by the United Nations to ensure a sustainable and equitable future by addressing social, economic, and environmental challenges. They are essential for reducing poverty, minimizing inequalities, protecting the environment, and promoting inclusive growth. The framework consists of 17 interconnected goals covering key areas such as education, health, gender equality, clean energy, and climate action. Each goal is supported by specific targets and measurable indicators to monitor progress and ensure accountability. The successful implementation of SDGs requires coordinated efforts at central, state, and district levels through effective policies and programs. Achieving these goals also depends on the active involvement of various stakeholders, including governments, institutions, industries, NGOs, and individuals.



The resource person highlighted that a faculty member's role extends beyond teaching to mentoring, facilitating learning, and supporting institutional and student development. From an organisational perspective, faculty are expected to align with the institution's vision, mission, and academic objectives while supporting research and administrative responsibilities. At the individual level, faculty focus on self-development, professional ethics, subject expertise, and continuous learning. Identifying competencies involves recognizing essential skills such as communication, critical thinking, leadership, and teamwork. A competency framework helps organize these skills into measurable areas for structured professional growth. Competences represent the required knowledge, skills, and attitudes, while competency is the effective application of these in real teaching and academic environments.



The resource person underlined that SDGs are key to realizing Viksit Bharat through collective and inclusive progress. The resource person emphasized that clearly defined roles at all levels—institutions, faculty, and students—are essential for effective implementation. Expected outcomes are measured through KPIs such as academic excellence, research, and sustainable practices, leading to improved organisational performance. The resource person also highlighted that these efforts contribute to societal impact by enhancing awareness, sustainability, and social equity.
