“Cyber Safe Generation: Awareness is your Best Defence”

Alumnae Association of GSSS Institute of Engineering & Technology for Women (GSSSIETW), Mysuru had organized an “Cyber Safe Generation: Awareness is your Best Defence” for 3rd Semester students of all branches on 20th November 2025 by the resource person Ms. Ruth R Associate Infrastructure Specialist, Kyndryl Cyber Crime Intervention Officer, ISAC, CopConnect (2025 batch ECE Alumnae)

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The session was organised for 3rd Semester students of all branches and was an interactive session, attended total number of 550 students. The session commenced by welcoming the resource person Ms. Ruth R Associate Infrastructure Specialist, Kyndryl Cyber Crime Intervention Officer, ISAC, CopConnect by Dr. M.Shivakumar President Alumnae Association Gsssietw, Mysuru and Mrs Usharani J Alumnae Association Secretary Gsssietw, Mysuru.

Ms. Ruth R explained how to stay safe while using digital devices and how cybercriminals exploit personal information. The main goal of this session was to promote awareness and encourage safe digital practices. Safe Use of Gadgets, phishing Awareness

Ms Ruth R explained common phishing techniques and ways to identify fake links and emails. Password Security: Importance of strong, unique passwords and multi-factor authentication. Mobile Safety: Avoiding unknown applications, checking permissions, and maintaining device security. Email Breach Check, Responsible AI Usage: Awareness about misuse of personal photos in random AI apps and deepfake risks. Also shared real cybercrime cases in India, including bank frauds, fake money transactions, loan app scams, fake job offers, trading scams, and sextortion. These examples helped students understand the seriousness of cyber threats. Students gained awareness about safe browsing, identifying suspicious messages, protecting financial information, and responsible digital usage. The session emphasized that awareness is the strongest defence against cybercrime.

The session was followed by the Interaction with the students. Finally, the Session was concluded with a remarkable vote of thanks, and received certificates, thanking **Ms. Ruth R** for sparing her valuable time to enlighten the students regarding Cyber Awareness.
